
Going to school is fun!

My family usually drops me off at school.




When I get to school I usually wait outside my classroom for the morning bell to ring.

for the teacher.




Then my teacher usually tells us the different activities we will be doing today.

When it is time for home we first pack up our areas and get our bags ready.




When the bell goes for home time our teacher says goodbye. School has finished!
